**BACKGROUND REPORT**

Stafford County Fire and Rescue Department uses Physio-Control LifePak 500 Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) to treat patients suffering from cardiac arrest. In November of 2005, the department applied for, and received a 50/50 competitive grant from the Office of Emergency Medical Services (OEMS) to purchase additional LifePak units. The matching funds obligation has been met in the FY06 budget. The grant funds awarded are in the amount of \$36,153, and will be used to upgrade and purchase additional LifePak 500 for County fire apparatus. The 15 new LifePaks 500 will be placed at the following locations:

- Brooke Volunteer Fire Department, to replace medically outdated AED and maintain EMS licensure.
- Hartwood Volunteer Fire Department, to replace medically outdated AED and maintain EMS licensure.
- Mountain View Volunteer Fire Department, to replace medically outdated non-standardized AED and maintain EMS licensure.
- Stafford Volunteer Fire Department, to replace medically outdated non-standardized AED and maintain EMS licensure.
- Rock Hill Volunteer Fire Department, to add AED to apparatus to maintain EMS licensure.

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT VIRGINIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY  
MEDICAL SERVICES HEALTH GRANT FUNDING FOR LIFEPAK 500  
AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILATORS
